We are still working to fill the principal's office with food. If you are able, please add another box of cereal or something to your grocery list and help us fill her office.

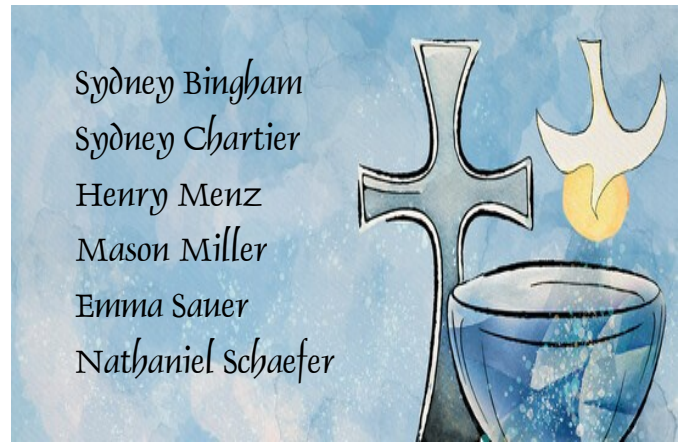
