Garuna means
grace, mercy
& compassion
in the Thai & Khmer languages

The population of Cambodia is now close to 17 million with fewer than 2% Christian. This ministry project helps share the grace (Garuna) of Jesus with children and their families by funding the construction and furnishing of a new classroom building at the growing Garuna Christian School in Tbong Khmum, Cambodia. The project will add a kindergarten program and more space for the students. This school is one of seven Garuna Schools open in Cambodia, serving 1,200 Lutheran students in grades K-6. Each school is designed for multi-use purposes, serving as both a school and as a location for community outreach and/or church plants for the Garuna Kids and their families.

The cost of building and furnishing a Garuna Christian School classroom:

- \$1500 will build outdoor bathrooms for boys and girls.
- \$100 will pay for one door or window.
- \$20 pays for 4 bags of cement.
- \$5 will buy 100 bricks.
- \$20 will buy a kindergarten desk and chair.
- \$1000 will pay for paint or tile for a classroom.
- \$100 buys a white board.

Pancakes w/Pastors

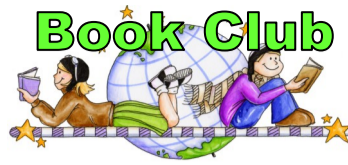
