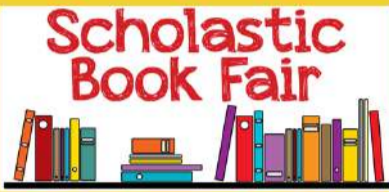

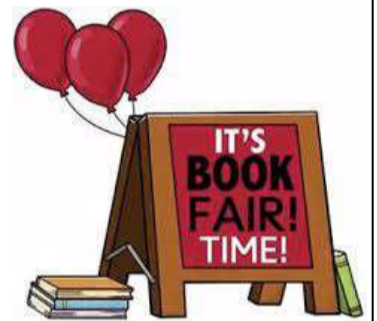
Next Week March 14-16, 2022
